Entry Fee £50 payable by online entry system for each event.

Players All must be over 40 on or before 7th February 2025. WST Pros must be over 45 and be ranked outside the 64 before the start of the 2024/25 Season on the Official 2 year WST World Ranking List

Number of Frames All matches Best of 7 Knockout.

Prize money Winner £500

Runner up £250

Losing Semi-finalists in each event £150

Losing Quarter Finalists in each event £75

High Break £50

Seeding Based on 128 entries.
The top 16 players who enter from the official WSS Ranking list will be seeded into position.

Players Players will need to agree to the terms and condition of the tour and hold a 2024/25 Tour Card.

Players Logo Players can wear two of their own logos, one should be placed on the arm of the shirt. WSS reserves the right to place two logos on each player if they choose.

Dress Code Full match attire with a bow tie or lounge tie. Collared shirt, tailored trousers with shoes.

Broadcasting No Broadcasting of this event is planned.

The Club The Club will be open for normal business during this event with no restrictions on guests or entry. The Snooker rooms will be reserved only for tournament play.

Ranking points Ranking points will run in line with the 2024/25 ranking policy

Non playing days	Players are permitted to enter and use the club on non-playing days
Practice Tables	There will be no designated practice tables on site, however players may be allocated a 5-minute slot to practice before their first match in their first event at the tournament director's discretion.
Top Up	The organiser reserves the right to top up from a reserve list for any withdrawals that occur after the draw and before the first day's play. The player offered the 'top up' will be in order from a reserve list and they will not know in advance the names of the other players in their group. Should a player withdraw during the event for any reason their next designated opponent would receive a bye.
Clashes	<p>Should WST or WSL move an event which creates a 'clash' after the player has entered both events the player must declare which event they are playing in and cannot participate in both.</p> <p>Should a player begin a WSS event and then withdraw to play in another event they will be subject to referral to the disciplinary panel</p>
