TOURNAMENT TERMS & CONDITIONS

ENTRY CONDITIONS

- The Tournament will be played subject to the Rules of Snooker as prescribed by the WPBSA.
- I have read, understood and agree to abide by the ABSC Player's Code of Ethics. Any breach of such rules or non-adherence to standard etiquette may result in disciplinary action being taken against the offenders. See: www.absc.com.au/governance
- Eligibility:
 - Players currently ranked outside the ABSC top 16 at close of entries
 - Players who have NOT won any WSF, IBSF, Oceania, Australian, NSW or other State Snooker Championship (Open category).
 - Players who have won 3 of the following (in any combination) are ineligible:
 - i. NSW Minors (Open category) or similar championship in another State
 - ii. Australian or State Masters
 - iii. State Intermediate
- National Rankings current as at close of entries will be considered before accepting entries.
- As this event is a State Championship all entrants are required to:
 - Comply with NSW residency criteria, i.e., must be a NSW resident and have been permanently domiciled in the State of NSW for a minimum period of six (6) months immediately prior to this event;
 - Entrants must be a financial member of a Snooker & Billiards NSW, and in good standing.
- A completed Online Entry and entry fee will be required before any player is permitted to compete.
- This entry form constitutes part of the conditions of entry. Changes to these terms & conditions may be made at the discretion of the Tournament Director, and I agree to abide by any such decision.
- By entering this tournament, I acknowledge and agree that:
 - I am bound by and must comply with all SBNSW Policies, including but not limited to, the ABSC Policies adopted by SBNSW – the ABSC National Integrity Framework, Anti-Doping Policy, Code of Conduct and Social Media Policy. All ABSC Policies can be found here www.absc.com.au/integrity
 - it is my responsibility to be familiar with these policies; and
 - a breach of these policies could result in disciplinary action being taken, as outlined in the complaints or discipline procedures for the relevant policy/ies.

TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

- Players eligible for prize money will need to provide the Tournament Director with their current bank account details (if not previously provided). All prize money will be paid by way of bank transfer.
- Dress Rules (please see attached for detailed information):
 - Fri & Sat: Snooker NSW Polo Shirts Or plain colored long sleeve shirt, with Dark Tailored Trousers, Dark Colored Plain Dress Shoes
 - Sun: Dark Tailored Trousers, Dark Colored Plain Dress Shoes, Long Sleeve Predominately Plain Colored Shirt Buttoned at the wrist, Waistcoat & Bow Tie.
- Failure to comply with these conditions will result in forfeiture of the match.
- All players are to report to the Tournament Director 30 minutes before their scheduled starting time and are to be ready to play at this time.
- Smoking or vaping is not permitted on the premises. Consumption of alcohol is not permitted whilst involved in a game.
- INDEMNITY: All participants enter at their own risk. None of the ABSC, SBNSW, Club, sponsors, or organisers shall be liable for any loss, injury or misadventure however arising.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- Format: straight knock-out, random draw, no seedings. Games will be best of five (5) frames; Final best of seven (7) frames.
- 1-2 last 16 games to be played Saturday. Remaining Last 16 to be played on Sunday.
- Prize money subject to entries and sponsorship.
- Players will be required to mark their own games, Referees in attendance from Sunday.
- Players are asked to please brush and pad the table on completion of their games.
- Entries will be capped at maximum 64
- Players within a 40km radius of venue must be available Friday night (7pm) if required
- Players will receive an email within 7 days of the tournament with the draw and important information.
- Standard Entry Fee: \$75 | Women/Juniors Enrtry Fee: \$25
- The closing date for entries is 5pm, 16th October 2025
