TOUR QUALIFIER 2 ENTRY PACK

Closing Date	Friday 18th September at 12 noon or when the event reaches 128 confirmed entries
Event Dates	Sunday 27th September 2026
Venue	The Crucible Sports and Social Club, 6 Richfield Avenue, Reading, RG1 8EQ
Entry Fee	£25 (Twenty Five pounds sterling) payable by online entry system for each event
Players	All players must be over 55 years old on or before 27th September 2026
Format	Best of 3 frames throughout
Prize Money	Winner £100 Runner Up £50 Semi Finalists £25
High break	£25 (Last 16 money is only paid if the event attracts more than 32 players)
Seeding	The top 8 players who enter on the official WSS Super Seniors ranking list will be seeded into position.
Players	Players will need to agree to the standard conditions of entry and hold a World Seniors 2026-27 Tour Card
Players Logo	Players can wear two of their own logos, one should be placed on the arm of the shirt. WSS reserves the right to place two logos on each player if they choose
Logo Embargo	No Snooker Cloth or table manufacturer may be advertised. Further logo embargo categories may be announced at WSS Discretion.
Dress Code	A long sleeved collared shirt or blouse, smart trousers and smart shoes. No jeans, no chinos, no trainers. You can if you wish add a waistcoat and bow or lounge tie.
Broadcasting	Players selected to play on the 'Arena Table' may have their match streamed live.
The Club	The Club will be open for normal business during this event with no restrictions on guests or entry to those playing in, or supporting those in the event. The Snooker Rooms will be reserved only for tournament play. The Arena table is played in a public area with an audience.
Ranking Points	Ranking Points will run in line with the 2026/2027 ranking policy
Non playing days	Players are permitted to enter and use the club on non playing days.
Practice tables	There will be no designated practice tables on site, however players will be allocated a 5 minute slot to practice before their first match of the event. Should the event be overrunning the tournament director can withdraw this at their discretion.
WST	Any current WST Professional is advised to apply for permission to participate in the WSS event should this date clash with any WST tournament.
Clashes	Should WST, or any snooker promoter, move an event which creates a 'clash' after the player has entered both events the player must declare which event they are playing in and cannot participate in both. Should a player begin in a WSS event and then withdraw to play in another event they will be subject to referral to the WPBSA disciplinary panel. Any Ranking points gained to the point of withdrawal will also not be allocated. The player will lose their entry fee in the WSS event should they enter and then withdraw to play in another event
