Tournament Terms & Conditions

ENTRY CONDITIONS

- Entrants must be a financial member of a Member State of the Australian Billiards and Snooker Council (ABSC), and in good standing, or if from another country, in good standing with their national federation.
- A completed online purchase for entry to the event constitutes acceptance of all terms and conditions and is required before any player is permitted to compete.
- The entry fee includes online transaction fees and GST.
- By entering this tournament, I acknowledge and agree that:
 - I am bound by and must comply with all ABSC Policies, including but not limited to, the National Integrity Framework, Anti-Doping Policy, Code of Conduct and Social Media Policy, which can be found here www.absc.com.au/integrity;
 - it is my responsibility to be familiar with these policies;
 - a breach of these policies could result in disciplinary action being taken, as outlined in the complaints or discipline procedures for the relevant policy/ies, and
 - I have read and understood and agree to abide by the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy, effective from 1 January 2021, and found on the Sport Integrity Australia website here: Australian National Anti-doping Policy. This is the anti-doping policy adopted by The Australian Billiards & Snooker Council and applicable to all members, participants and nonparticipants.
- All players are required to complete the Sport Integrity Australia Anti-Doping Fundamentals on-line course which is available on the Sports Integrity Australia website - https://elearning.sportintegrity.gov.au/user_login. You will need to create an account to access the course. Once you have completed it, you will receive an electronic Certificate of Attainment. Please register using the same email address you use to enter tournaments, and select Billiards & Snooker as your sport.
- You may be required to produce your course completion certificate as a condition of entry.

TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

- The Tournament will be played subject to the Rules of Snooker as prescribed by the WPBSA.
- ABSC Playing Conditions and all provisions of the Player's Code of Ethics will also be adhered to. Any breach of such rules or non-adherence to standard etiquette may result in disciplinary action being taken against the offenders. See: [https://absc.com.au/integrity](http://absc.com.au/integrity)
- All prize money will be paid by way of bank transfer. Players will need to provide the tournament director with bank account details, and international players will additionally need to provide their bank's SWIFT code and their residential address, in order for prize money to be paid.

TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS CONTINUED

- International players requiring an Invitation Letter to assist with obtaining a visa should email secretary@absc.com.au. Please apply for a visa as soon as possible as processing delays are common.
- Smoking or vaping is not permitted on the premises. Consumption of alcohol is not permitted whilst involved in a game.
- Dress Rules:
 - Fri & Sat: Snooker NSW Polo Shirts or Current Official State or ABSC Polo Or plain colored long sleeve shirt, with Dark Tailored Trousers, Dark Colored Plain Dress Shoes
 - Sun: Dark Tailored Trousers, Dark Colored Plain Dress Shoes, Long Sleeve Predominately Plain Colored Shirt Buttoned at the wrist, Waistcoat & Bow Tie.
 - Failure to comply with these conditions will result in forfeiture of the match.
- All players are to report to the Tournament Director 30 minutes before their scheduled starting time and are to be ready to play at this time.
- In the absence of official referees, players will be required to referee their games in the early rounds. Official referees will be made available on Sunday.
- Players are required to brush and pad the table on completion of their games.
- Players will receive an email when the draw is published, the email will contain important information about the event.
- Interstate and NSW country players will not be required until after midday Friday.
- Changes to these terms & conditions may be made at the discretion of the Tournament Director, and I agree to abide by any such decision.
- INDEMNITY: All participants enter at their own risk. Neither the ABSC, SBNSW, Club Marconi, sponsors, nor organisers shall be liable for any loss, injury or misadventure however arising.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT AND ENTRY FEES

- Seedings will apply based on the National Snooker Rankings as per the ABSC website.
- Straight knock-out over best of five (5) frames; Final best of seven (7) frames.
- Prize money of \$12,000, subject to entries
- Entry Fees are:
 - Standard Entry: \$130
 - Women, Juniors (U/18): \$50
