ENTRY CONDITIONS

- Eligibility: As this event is a State Championship all entrants are required to:
 - Comply with NSW residency criteria, i.e., must be a NSW resident and have been permanently domiciled in the State of NSW for a minimum period of six (6) months immediately prior to this event.
 - Not have previously competed in another State Championship of the same discipline (i.e. Snooker) in the same calendar year.
- Entrants must be a financial member of Snooker & Billiards NSW, and in good standing.
- A completed online purchase for entry to the event (including payment) constitutes acceptance of all terms and conditions and is required before any player is permitted to compete. Entry includes online transaction fee.
- By entering this tournament I acknowledge and agree that:
 - I am bound by and must comply with all SBNSW Policies, including but not limited to, the ABSC Policies adopted by SBNSW - the ABSC National Integrity Framework, Anti-Doping Policy, Code of Conduct and Social Media Policy. All ABSC Policies can be found here www.absc.com.au/integrity
 - it is my responsibility to be familiar with these policies.
 - a breach of these policies could result in disciplinary action being taken, as outlined in the complaints or discipline procedures for the relevant policy/ies; and
 - I have read and understood and agree to abide by the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy, effective from 1 January 2021, and found here: [Australian National Anti-doping Policy](#) being the anti-doping policy adopted by the Australian Billiards & Snooker Council and applicable to all members, participants and nonparticipants.
- All players are required to complete the Sport Integrity Australia Anti-Doping Fundamentals on-line course which is available on the Sports Integrity Australia website – [SIA eLearning Login](#). You will need to create an account to access the course, and once completed you will be sent an electronic certificate of attainment that you may be required to produce as a condition of entry.
- Official photos and/or videos may be taken during the event and used by SBNSW and ABSC for promotional purposes, including publication on relevant channels. Attendance indicates your consent to such use. If you do not wish to appear in such materials, please notify the event organiser prior to the event.
- Entry of a junior (under 18) constitutes acceptance of these terms & conditions by their parent/guardian. Juniors must be accompanied by a parent/guardian at all times.

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TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

- The Tournament will be played subject to the Rules of Snooker as prescribed by the WPBSA.
- ABSC Playing Conditions and all matters pertaining to the Player's Code of Ethics will also be adhered to. Any breach of such rules or non-adherence to standard etiquette may result in disciplinary action being taken against the offenders. See: www.absc.com.au/integrity
- Players eligible for prize money will need to provide the Tournament Organiser with their bank account details. All prize money will be paid by way of bank transfer.
- Dress Rules:
 - SATURDAY ONLY: Official SBNSW or ABSC Polo shirt OR collared dress shirt with sleeves below the elbows; Dark trousers or dark skirts, no shorter than kneecap, dress ladies dark-coloured shoes (open or closed toe) shall be worn to all sessions.
 - SUNDAY: Collared dress shirt with sleeves below the elbows (NO POLOS) Dark trousers or dark skirts, no shorter than kneecap, dress ladies dark-coloured shoes (open or closed toe) shall be worn to all sessions. Waistcoat is required for the knock-out stage.
 - Failure to comply with these conditions may result in forfeiture of the game.
- Failure to comply with these conditions will result in forfeiture of the match.
- All players are to report to the Tournament Director 30 minutes before their scheduled starting time and are to be ready to play at this time.
- Smoking or vaping is not permitted on the premises. Consumption of alcohol is not permitted whilst involved in a game.
- Changes to these terms & conditions may be made at the discretion of the Tournament Director, and I agree to abide by any such decision.
- INDEMNITY: All participants enter at their own risk. None of the SBNSW, venue, sponsors, or organisers shall be liable for any loss, injury or misadventure however arising.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- Round robin (best of 3), followed by a knockout stage (best of 3). Semi-finals and final: best of 5. Format subject to change depending on entries and available time.
- Prize money subject to entries received.
- Players will be required to mark their own games. Referees in attendance from Sunday, subject to availability.
- Entry fees: Adult - \$60 | Under 18 - \$30
